Tour: Fabyan Japanese Garden and Villa with docent Rose Moore

Discover the wonders of the Fabyan Japanese garden and Villa, home of Colonel George and Nelle Fabyan from 1905 to 1939, called Riverbank. They hired Frank Lloyd Wright to enlarge and re-model the existing farmhouse.

The Fabyan's Japanese Garden was installed in 1910, and is a tranquil oasis where history melds with nature and design.

Garden/Villa Directions and Parking: Off Route 31, turn east on the first turn north of Fabyan Pkwy. Drive on the paved road to the parking lot and walk the short distance to the garden. After the garden tour, we will tour the Villa.
