



## **CALL FOR NOMINATIONS**

### **2006 Users' Meeting Featured Student Talks**

The Graduate Student Association of the Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory, with the support of the Users' Executive Committee, will for the first time, solicit nominations for graduate students to present their work at the upcoming, 2006 Users' Meeting.

These students are expected to:

- anticipate graduation within approximately one year
- have a good physics result produced by the student
- be a good and experienced speaker

All nominated students need to have:

- a letter of support from their doctoral adviser
- a one page paper describing the research result they produced
- a short CV highlighting their past experiences with presenting a scientific result
- turned in all application materials by **April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2006**

Four students will be chosen by a three member committee assembled by the GSA.

The entries will be judged on the following criteria:

- significance of the student's contribution to the scientific community
- the quality of the scientific result
- the ability of the student to communicate the result

**The chosen talks will be announced May 1st, and be presented by the students at the Annual User's Meeting in June.**
