Signs need to be ready for pick up at noon on September 26, 2008

For display starting September 26, 2008 to October 17, 2008

Rare events for experiments, no events for safety

It's fall: leave falls to the leaves.

Don't be a big foot when it comes to your carbon
footprint.

Signs need to be ready for pick up at noon on November 14, 2008

For display until December 5, 2008

Pedestrians: Cross where expected to be detected.
