<p><b>Medical Comments:</b> Reaching into a bin of miscellaneous metal parts, employee sustained a quarter inch laceration on distal tip of right ring finger.</p> <p><b>ESH Comments:</b> The employee had removed his leather gloves to walk back to his desk area. Enroute, the employee decided to look for a small piece of stainless steel in a scrap pile. As he reached for a piece that he found, his finger came into contact with a sharp edge, producing a small laceration. (RCR)</p>

<p><b>Medical Comments:</b> Employee stepped out of van; slipped and fell on icy, unsalted pavement. Fell on right hip and buttock, but sustained no apparent injury.</p> <p><b>ESH Comments:</b></p>

<p><b>Medical Comments:</b> Employee was re-entering building after spreading salt on areas of pavement which had recently been shoveled. Employee fell on back, buttocks and back of head, but did not have any complaint of injury.</p> <p><b>ESH Comments:</b> The employee was walking in a parking lot area recently plowed (it had snowed the night before) but not salted. The area has a slight slope to it. The employee was not injured, but reported to Medical as a precaution.</p>

<p><b>Medical Comments:</b> Employee was walking through aisle, and caught left foot on sawhorses. Sawhorses fell against employee, causing abrasions on forearms.</p> <p><b>ESH Comments:</b></p>

<p><b>Medical Comments:</b> While using a jig saw to cut the bottom off a metal door (while wearing safety glasses with side shield), employee felt particles strike face, and foreign body lodge in left eye. Nurse was able to remove it.</p>										

**ESH Comments:** The employee, needing bifocals, was wearing visitor glasses over his Rx safety glasses to provide side shields. Upon feeling pieces hitting his face, employee switched to chemical goggles in which stick-on bifocals had been added. No further incident after foreign object removed. (RCR)



