<p>Medical Comments: Employee was attempting to remove epoxy from a mold (without face shield). A piece of epoxy broke loose and struck employee on right side of chin, causing a laceration.</p> <p>ESH Comments: The individual was working in IB-2 preparing to break epoxy off of magnet coils. He was checking the stability of the material with a pry bar when a piece of the epoxy popped off and caused an abrasion on his chin. The individual had not yet put on his face shield. There was a small amount of blood so the individual went to the restroom to clean up and then reported to medical. He returned to work and was required to keep his chin clean and dry.</p>
