Medical Comments: Driver was unloading helium from tank truck; fell backward from 1-foot high step (on vehicle). Driver then lost consciousness, and fell, incurring abrasion to face and contusion to left knee. First aid treatment provided at local medical facility.

ESH Comments: On 1/31/2009, at approximately 2000 hours, a supply vendor was off-loading a truck delivery of helium. To operate the blow-down valve, he was required to use the truck mounted step and grab bar to step-up 12 inches. The worker failed to use the "grab bar" and fell backwards, striking his head on the pavement. The worker was given first-aid treatment at a local hospital, but the Loss of consciousness makes this case OSHA Recordable. GBM, BSS-SSO.

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Medical Comments: Employee had to lay down on the door frame of a power supply unit in order to repair some fittings. This caused pain and strain in left, lower rib area.

ESH Comments: The incident occurred while the employee was working on a Main Injector magnet power supply inside of the MI-20 Service Building. Pads are available which can be placed over the bottom of the door frame to provide cushioning when working on power supplies of this type, but no pad was used in this instance. First aid treatment only; no limitations.
