ESH Comments: Employee 1 was transporting plastic planks on a rolling cart with employee 2. As employee 1 was trying to negotiate the rolling cart between a table and a wooden crate, his left hand contacted the table resulting in a laceration of the left index finger and the middle finger. The index finger laceration required 9 sutures; the middle finger only required first aid. The injury is recordable, not DART.
