Medical Comments: Employee was eating lunch after a safety meeting; received 3 insect (yellow jacket?) stings: on left eyebrow, right thumb and left elbow. Later noticed nest under the table.

ESH Comments: The employee and several others sat down at an aluminum picnic table in a grassy area to the east of Lab 1 (Cut Shop). No one had noticed any flying insect activity as they approached the table. As the employee sat down on the end of one of the benches, the wasps flew out from underneath the table and stung him in the indicated locations. The table had been borrowed from MDTL for the day. It was moved with a forklift and hand carried into place without incident or observed insect activity. After the attack, a nest was discovered inside one of the support tubes underneath the table. The nest was subsequently sprayed with insecticide. The Machine Shop noted that the aluminum picnic tables already located in their area have had the hollow tubes plugged to prevent wasps from building nests in them. Consideration should be given to checking all such tubes on the aluminum picnic tables and plugging them to prevent similar incidents.

He reported to the Medical Office later in the morning of 7/23/10 and was sent home, unable to work. Re-evaluated by Medical Office on 7/26/10 and returned to work with job-limiting restrictions. Case is DART.
