**Medical Comments:** An employee was using a flux pen, a bristle fell out of the pen and landed on the lower lid of (and partially in) employee's right eye, causing irritation.

**ESH Comments:** The employee was working at her bench doing printed circuit board assembly when the incident occurred. After using a flux pen, the employee developed pain and redness in the right eye. The employee rinsed her eye at the local eyewash station and then reported to the Medical Office where a small fiber resembling a bristle from the flux pen was removed from her right eye. It is not understood exactly how the bristle might have become detached from the pen and reached the employee's eye, but it is suspected the bristle was pulled loose when the employee uncapped the pen prior to use. The MSDS for the chemical used in the flux pen was evaluated by safety and medical personnel. The chemical did not pose a significant eye hazard and only a minute amount of the chemical would have been present on the bristle. First aid treatment only; no limitations.
