Medical Comments: Fell down on ice while carrying ladder.

ESH Comments: The employee was part of crew working to repair the faulted 13.8 kV bus duct located outside of the MI 10 Service Building. The area in which they were working was covered with snow and ice due to the recent blizzard. Snow shoveling was done to gain access to the bus duct. While carrying a 6 ft step ladder to work on the equipment, the employee slipped and fell. He did not experience pain at that time, so he continued working. As the day progressed, he began to experience pain in his back and his supervisor directed him to report to the Medical Office. First aid treatment was provided and he was given restrictions for the remainder of the day. He reported back to the Medical Office at the beginning of his shift the next day and was returned to work with no limitations. Case is neither DART nor recordable, since restrictions applied only to the day of injury and only first aid treatment was provided.
