**Medical Comments:** While reaching for electrical box on cart "hitch" fell down striking employee on left eye orbit.

**ESH Comments:** The incident occurred in the Cross Gallery vacuum pump repair shop. The employee had knelt down next to a cart-mounted vacuum pump assembly in order to remove a component located at the bottom of the cart when the steel towing bar on the cart rotated down from the vertical position and the end of the bar struck him in the face just below the left eye. The employee reported to the Medical Office where he received first aid treatment and returned to work with no limitations. Standard practice is to use a retaining pin attached to the towing bar to secure the bar in the upright position, but the hole where that pin should be placed had been covered by a device attached to the top of this particular unit and the bar had not been secured.

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**Medical Comments:** Employee was struck on left side of forehead by flange while unrolling flex hose.

**ESH Comments:** The incident occurred at CHL. The employee was pulling a corrugated bellows vacuum hose off of a storage rack. The hose was entangled with other hoses in the rack and when he pulled the hose free, the end of the hose whipped toward him and he was struck on the forehead by the flange on the end of the hose, resulting in small laceration. He reported to the Medical Office where he received first aid treatment and returned to work with no limitations.
