**Medical Comments:** While surveying a dumpster of scrap metal he was stung by a bee on his right cheek.

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**Medical Comments:** While on a platform in Chicago he turned and stepped on an eye bolt. While attempting to get better footing he slipped off platform and fell about 3 feet, landing on right thumb, right knee, right wrist and back. Went t to Adventist ER on 6/26/12 and Concentra on 6/27/12. RX given.

**ES&H Comments:** The individual, a subcontract technician, was part of a team of lab personnel who were working offsite at a vendor's facility where electron beam welding was being performed on an accelerator component. While stepping between two levels of a support structure associated with the welding machinery, the individual lost his footing and fell off the 38" high platform, resulting in injuries to his right hand and thumb (strain) and his right knee and back (abrasions). He received treatment at an offsite medical facility and was directed not to work on the day following the incident. He returned to work two days after the incident on restrictions which

prevent him from performing some of his routine job functions. Although prescription medication was given and the case involves lost days, this case does not meet the criteria for recordability since the individual's contracting company has less than 10 personnel working on site.

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**Medical Comments:** In the afternoon patient noted itching on right bicep. Insect bite.

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**Medical Comments:** While exiting building to outside was stung twice - left tricep/ right forehead.

**ES&H Comments:** The employee was exiting the south personnel door of IB-2A shortly after the start of his shift. As he exited, he felt something sting his upper arm. He brushed his arm, and the insect flew up and stung him on his forehead. The employee went to Medical where he received first aid treatment. Upon returning to his work station, the employee noted two wasp nests in the process of being built on the upper frame of the door that had not been there the previous day. The employee eradicated the nests with insecticide spray. An examination of the upper eaves of the building, a known location for wasp nests, noted some additional activity. The Building Manager was informed, who in turn contacted Roads & Grounds requesting that the exterminator pay a visit to IB-2A on Monday. (The incident occurred on Friday.)

**ES&H Comments:** The employee stated that he did not know where he came into contact with the poison ivy; whether at work, at home, or at the golf course. The employee is aware of how to identify poison ivy and he did not find any at his primary/secondary work locations (Railhead). Should he find the plant in the workplace, he will contact Roads and Grounds and they will apply target-specific herbicides if needed.


