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Medical Comments: While leaving the building, the employee stepped on a rug and it slipped out from under her. She rolled her right foot, landed on right knee, right hip, right pelvis, right hand and right wrist. The employee went to ER where x-rays were taken. A rigid splint was given in the ER for the right wrist.

ES&H Comments: On Monday July 9, 2012 at approximately 4:15p.m. a PPD employee was exiting the MI-8 Service Building when the incident occurred. The employee stated that the crew she was working with had just completed the task for the day and was heading back to their office. Two coworkers exited the building first. The employee stated that as she stepped on the floor mat with her right foot by the exit door it slid quickly to her left. The employee stated she fell striking her right wrist, and the right side of her body to the concrete floor. She went to the onsite Fire Department where they observed the wrist and then she elected to proceed to Rush Copley Hospital without assistance. She was diagnosed with a potential right wrist fracture. The right wrist was dressed with a rigid splint with an ACE wrap to immobilize the area. X-rays of her right foot, right knee, right hip and right pelvis areas came back negative She reported to the onsite Medical office

this morning, Tuesday July 10, 2012, for an evaluation and she was sent home for the remainder of the day.
