Medical Comments: While entering the building in a hurried manner (due to rain storm), the employee tripped on the rug, slid on the wet concrete floor and fell into the elevator door. He suffered a laceration on the top of his head. He was transported to the hospital where 19 staples were applied to close the wound.

ES&H Comments: At approximately 6:30am an employee was rushing into the D0 building to avoid a storm. As the door was opened a gust of wind caught the floor mat blowing it up causing the employee to trip. As he tripped his other foot slid on the wet floor causing him to fall head first into the elevator. The employee was transported to Delnor Hospital and 19 staples were administered to his head. This was a DART event resulting in 1 lost day. EM 7/27

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Medical Comments: While driving on site, the employee was stung by an insect on the left arm.

ES&H Comments: The employee was driving from the Central Helium Liquefier back to his office in MW9. As he was driving along Road A with the vehicle windows open, a wasp entered the vehicle and stung him on his left forearm. He reported to the Medical Office and received first aid treatment. He returned to work with no limitations.

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Medical Comments: While leaving the building out of the SW door, the door hit a wasp's nest and the employee got stung on his upper, right arm.

ES&H Comments: The employee was exiting the Main Injector tunnel at MI-62 through the seldom used exit door at the top of the tunnel access stairs. As he opened the door and began to walk out the doorway, the top of the door contacted a wasp nest which had been built along the top of the exterior side of the door frame. The wasps in the nest became agitated and, as the employee attempted to escape from them; one wasp stung him on the upper right arm. He reported to the

Medical Office where he received first aid treatment and returned to work with no limitations. The nest was removed later in the day.

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Medical Comments: While removing a window from a house, it shattered and the employee received a laceration 1/4" in diameter in the left upper chest.

ES&H Comments: The employee was performing general exterior building cleaning at 21 Shabbona including the washing of windows. In the process of removing the upper portion of a combination storm window assembly (era 1965), the window broke in place and a piece of broken glass fell onto the employees chest resulting in a laceration. The employee reported to the Fermilab Medical Office and First-aid was given (cleaning of the wound). The employee was wearing safety glasses and leather gloves. Note that this is the only BSS Village House unit with this era of windows; the other units had window upgrades in 1980's but this unit belonged to another D/S at that time and did not receive window replacement. Future window cleaning will be done with the windows left in place. This unit is not being used as residential but for storage.
