Medical Comments: While leaving the parking lot, the employee tried to avoid a pipe extending from a tank and slipped. She fell forward causing an abrasion to her right palm and left knee.

ES&H Comments: The employee was walking to her work area in the A0 Lab building from where she had parked her car in the F4 portakamp parking lot. An LN2 tank trailer is parked in the packed gravel hardstand area south of the A0 Lab entrance door. Minimizing the walking distance to the door, the employee walked immediately adjacent to the front of the trailer, which has 2 padded pipes extending 8 inches from the front. As she adjusted her path to avoid the front of the trailer, she lost her footing on the pieces of loose gravel from the hardstand that had been displaced onto the paved area on which she was walking and fell to the pavement, resulting in knee and hand abrasions. She reported to the Medical Office where she received first aid treatment and returned to work with no restrictions. The loose gravel on the pavement was swept back into the hardstand area following the incident.

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Medical Comments: While cutting a metal pipe with a cut off saw, the saw kicked back striking the subcontractor in the left arm causing a laceration.

ES&H Comments: *Although this case occurred last quarter it was not entered until this quarter due to late reporting by the subcontractor.

The subcontractor was using a cutoff saw to remove conduit from an abandoned utility. At the end

of the cut the saw bound kicking back and striking the subcontractor on his left arm causing a laceration. He received first aid at the job site trailer and returned to work. Later in the evening the subcontractor went to a medical clinic for treatment and received several stitches. He returned to work the next day with no restrictions. This case is recordable.

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Medical Comments: While swinging a maul the handle struck the subcontractor's elbow causing swelling.

ES&H Comments: *Although this case occurred last quarter it was not entered until this quarter due to late reporting by the subcontractor.

While loosening the tension on a shoring tower, the subcontractor swung a "beater" (small sledge hammer) and missed his target causing the beater handle to strike his elbow. The contusion was evaluated by the (off site) medical clinic and the subcontractor received first aid treatment only after a negative x-ray.


