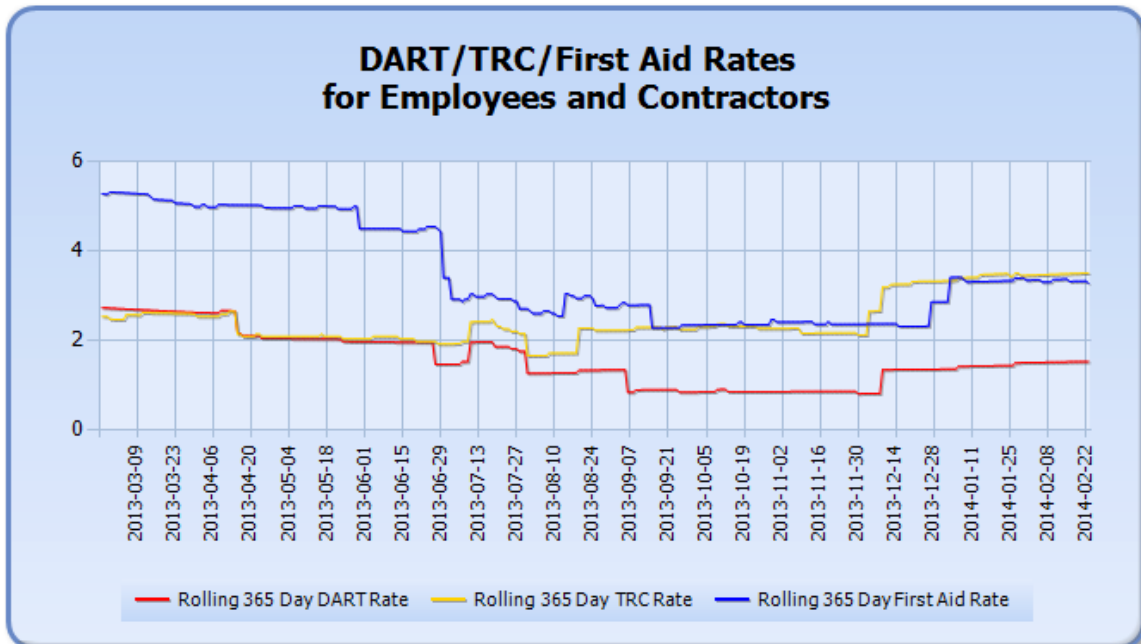
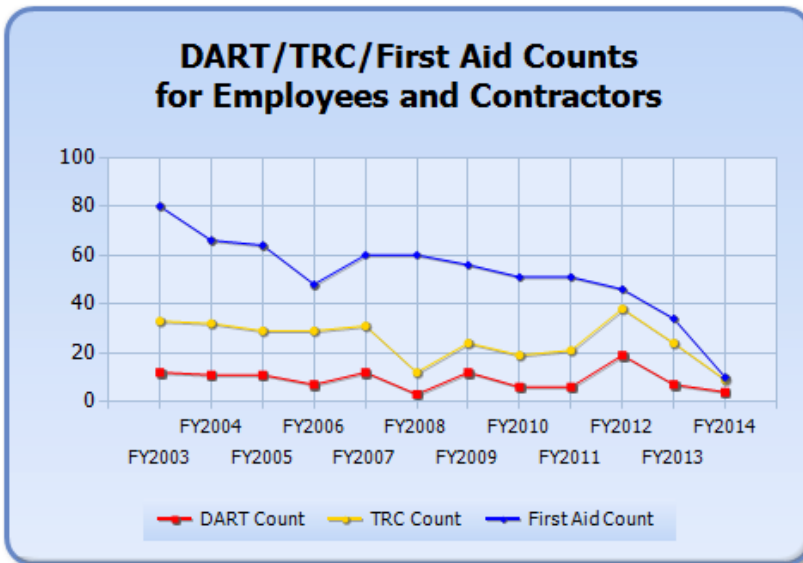

Medical Comments: While working in the main injector the employee hit is head. Noticed a scrap last evening. Reported to medical 2/21/14. No treatment - report only.

ESH Comments: The incident occurred in the MI-10 region of the Main Injector tunnel. The employee was part of the team installing an Ion Profile Monitor. He was standing on a ladder and leaning over to perform a portion of the work when the top of his head struck the bottom of a cable tray. He appeared to suffer no injury and continued working. After he had gone home for the day, he noticed a small scab in the area where he struck the cable tray. He reported the incident to the Medical Office the following morning. No treatment was necessary and he returned to work with no limitations. Head protection is not required in the tunnel, but bump caps are available for use on tasks where low headroom is an issue.
