Medical Comments: Employee was turning a nut using a wrench. Was bent forward because of the tight quarters when he felt a stabbing pain to his lower back on the left side. He tried to walk it off but felt a popping sensation once while walking. Given first aid and will re-evaluate on 8/4/15.

ESH Comments: The injury occurred while the employee was working in the Main Injector tunnel. The employee was adjusting alignment nuts on a piece of beam pipe (known as the "beam box") mounted on a stand, prior to moving the beam pipe into position in the new beamline. The pipe is 8 inches in diameter and was at waist height. To reach the nuts on the opposite side of the pipe from where he was standing, the employee had to reach over the pipe with his left hand, which was holding a wrench, while bent over at the waist. As he was attempting to adjust one of the nuts on the opposite side of the pipe, he twisted while being bent over and immediately felt pain in his lower back. He stood up and waited to see if the pain would abate, but it did not. He reported to the Medical Office where he received first aid treatment for a back strain and was sent home for the day. The following day the pain had increased and the employee went to an off-site medical facility for further evaluation and treatment. He was directed by the off-site physician to stay off work for the remainder of the week, making this a DART case. The employee reported to the Medical Office on Monday, 8/10/2015, and was returned to work with limitations which do not prevent him from performing his routine job functions.


