Medical Comments: While returning to truck, employee slipped on snow-covered ice, landing on head, left shoulder and hip. Complained of back and neck pain. Sent to local clinic for evaluation.										
ESH Comments: Employee states that when he returned to MAB, he had no indication that there was ice underneath the snow (i.e. no slips, no visible signs) when he entered the building. But when he came back to truck with welding rods, he slipped where drive slopes away from the building. Two downspouts next to overhead door appear to be source of ice buildup. Area had not been salted.

Lessons Learned from other Labs:

On 12/27/07, a PNNL electrician removed two 120-volt power cords from a bundle of four de-energized 120-volt power cords that had been secured together with duct tape and tagged with a Danger Tag used by authorized workers in PNNL's LOTO program. The Danger Tag had been placed by an R&D staff member who was not present when the tag was removed by the electrician. Removal of the Danger Tag and the two power cords by a person other than the individual who installed the tag constitutes a significant noncompliance with SBMS requirements for LOTO. Unauthorized removal of the tag was discovered on 1/4/08 by the employee who originally placed the tag. The event was subsequently categorized as a reportable event and a critique was held on 1/8/08.
