<p>Medical Comments: Employee was walking in parking lot; slipped on icy pavement, covered with snow, and fell to ground. Employee tried to break fall with left hand, injuring wrist. Fall impact also sprained neck and back. Treated at area clinic with splint.</p> <p>ESH Comments: The employee slipped on snow-covered ice in an area adjacent to parking lot and injured left wrist. The nature of the injury and extent of severity required medical treatment (rigid wrist splint) and restricted work activity. The case is an OSHA DART. Incident investigation and HPI-causal analysis initiated. GBM-BSS-SSO.</p>

<p>Medical Comments: While exiting vehicle at Lab B, employee stepped on icy patch of pavement, then fell, striking right elbow and right hip. The area was salted following the incident. First aid treatment only; no limitations.</p>

<p>Medical Comments: Employee slipped and fell on icy pavement, impacting right wrist and hand. Sent to area clinic which applied splint.</p> <p>ESH Comments: The employee slipped on snow-covered ice in a drive way outside of Lab 1 and injured right wrist. The nature of the injury and extent of severity required medical treatment (rigid wrist splint) and restricted work activity (1 day). The case is an OSHA DART. Incident investigation and HPI causal analysis initiated. GBM-BSS-SSO.</p>

<p>Medical Comments: While stepping up on a stool to remove a cable, employee hit top of head on a copper pipe end, lacerating top of scalp (not a hard hat area).</p>									
<p>ESH Comments: Employee was using moveable safety steps to remove old internet cable from overhead. The cable was threaded over pipes within a cable bundle. As the employee stepped up on the first step, he hit his head on a copper pipe that had been cut off and crimped rather than capped. The employee is from the software group and rarely works in this part of the building. He was unaware that bump caps are used by the technicians on the floor when working in tight quarters around all the piping.</p>
