<p><b>Medical Comments:</b> Employee hit desk top with right hand in anger due to loss of computer data. Caused contusion to right #5 finger.</p>									
<p><b>ESH Comments:</b> The student is a participant in the Pre-Service Teacher (PST) program at Fermilab. The student was using a laptop computer supplied to him by the Fermilab Education Department, and it kept heating up. The student had six weeks of data stored on the computer that he needed to complete the requirements for his PST program. The laptop severely overheated and fried the hard drive, resulting in the loss of the data that he had collected at the lab. The student became upset and slammed his right fist on his desk. His little finger hurt at that point, and he thought he had heard something crack. He became concerned that he may have broken his finger, and went to Medical. The student was sent out for an X-ray, which proved negative. This is therefore a first aid only case. Per OSHA rules, since the student's intent was not to intentionally hurt himself, this first aid injury is considered work related. The medical restrictions do not limit the employee in performing his normal duties. [RCR 7/16/2009]</p>
