<p><b>Medical Comments:</b> Employee was struck by a "golf" cart (driving by) while standing next to another cart; caused contusion and knee strain on right leg.</p> <p><b>ESH Comments:</b> (Main Injector 100 sector) Employee 1 was standing in front of her motorized cart while employee 2 was moving his cart around her cart. As employee 2's cart was passing employee 1's cart (at an appropriate rate of speed), the rear of employee 2's cart contacted the rear of employee 1's cart. This contact resulted in employee 1's cart lunging forward, propelling it into employee 1's right calf. Employee was evaluated by medical and released with no restrictions or limitations.</p>

<p><b>Medical Comments:</b> While looking for a leak on the service building roof, employee received 2 wasp stings on the left forearm. Antibiotic medication was given (next day) to prevent cellulites.</p> <p><b>ESH Comments:</b> While performing roof inspection, the employee used his gloved hand to swat at a wasp that had landed on a ventilation fan exhaust hood next to the employee. The employee struck the exhaust hood as he swatted at the wasp, resulting in numerous wasps flying out from a nest that was hidden inside the exhaust hood. Employee stung twice on the left forearm. First aid treatment only; no limitations. Update 8/18/09: Prescription medication prescribed the day following the incident makes the case recordable.</p>
