**Medical Comments:** Subcontractor was working on sextagon platform; while stepping from platform to floor, stepped on some flexible tubing which moved, causing subcontractor to twist right ankle.

**ESH Comments:** At approximately 2:30PM, a contract welder was welding a MINERvA plane on the strong back stand at PB7. The contractor was repositioning himself into the center of the MINERvA plane to continue welding. As the contractor stepped down off of the plane into the center of the strong back (approx. 17" elevation change), he stepped on the smoke eater tubing (approx. 2.5" tubing) twisting his ankle. The contractor fell forward bracing himself with his hands. The only injury was a sprained ankle. The contractor was working on an established project, with procedure and HA. He was wearing full welding PPE and steel toe boots with 4" ankle support. Lighting in the area or visibility of snorkel was not an issue. During repositioning the contractor was carrying his welding hose. Employee returned to work with limitations of no prolonged standing and mostly sitting work.
