Medical Comments: Employee was grinding metal yesterday (2/01/10); noticed pain in left eye after work. Reported to medical office today, where the foreign body was removed.

ESH Comments: The employee was using a handheld grinder at New Muon Lab. He was wearing safety glasses underneath a face shield while using the grinder and did not have any eye irritation during the job. He developed eye irritation after he went home for the day, several hours after completion of the grinding. The irritation persisted into the following day, so he reported to the Medical Office, where a foreign body was removed from his left eye. First aid treatment only; no limitations. It is suspected that some of the metal particles generated during the grinding had become trapped in the employee's hair and that, at some point in the evening, the material fell into his eye.
