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**Medical Comments:** 6-foot section of channel metal fell onto head of subcontractor, causing contusion.

**ESH Comments:** A contract employee working in ICB installing a section of security fence was hit in the head by a piece of falling light metal. The metal piece was the top rail for the fence. Three employees were installing the eight foot high fence sections, and at the time of the incident, were working in a tight location along a set of stairs. The employees had talked through an installation procedure, which included one of the employees positioning and holding the top rail in place while the other two employees moved the fence sections into place. One of the employees went to the Stock Room to acquire fasteners, and before the top rail was secured in place, the contract employee knelt down under the stairs to reposition a section of fence. The movement of the fence caused the top rail to fall off the top of the fence section, strike the stairs, and fall between the stairs and the fence, striking the employee in the head. The contract employee was sent off site by Medical, where he received first aid treatment for a bump on his head. The employee was returned to work without limitation. The direct supervisor of the activity stated that in his opinion the employee was working in a hurry up mode. The employee has been instructed to work at a slower (safer) pace. For future work on the fence, the person holding the top rail in place will also temporarily secure the rail in place to prevent any inadvertent dropping of the rail.
