## The Dawn of a new Era: Gravitational-Wave Astronomy

The LIGO detectors have detected gravitational waves for the first time ever. The source GW150914 is a pair of heavy black holes that coalesce causing the most powerful explosion of energy ever detected. I will discuss the discovery and its implications for astrophysics.
