


<p>Medical Comments: Contractor was flushing out resin from a tank, while looking into the tank a drop of water splashed into his eye - causing a burning sensation. Contractor was wearing safety glasses. Eye was rinsed in medical and contractor advised to contact employer for referral for follow up.</p> <p>ESH Comments: The subcontract technician was working with two AD employees at the Central Utility Building. They were draining and rinsing out a large deionized water tank (column) that had contained resin beads and water. One employee was on top of an elevated platform using a hose to spray water into the interior of the tank to clean it and rinse out any remaining beads, while the subcontract technician was down on the floor by the tank's drainage port with a bucket to capture the rinse water and beads. The contract technician thought that the employee on the platform had stopped washing the tank out. To confirm that no more water was being sprayed, he bent over to look into the port. (The area is noisy and the technician could not hear if the water spray was on.) As he bent over, his safety glasses slipped down his nose. At the same time, the employee on the top of the mezzanine sprayed water again and droplets came out of the open port and splashed onto the contract technician's face, with a small amount of water contacting his right eye due to the slippage of his safety glasses. The resin residue is a slight irritant to eyes and skin. He went to the onsite Medical Office where he was evaluated and his eyes were cleaned and flushed with water (first aid treatment). He returned to work without restrictions. The supervisor on the job site and the group leader were advised to have personnel wear safety goggles, rather than safety glasses, to prevent the rinse water from contacting their eyes in the future. The subcontract technician has only been on the job for about one month and this was the first time he was assisting in this activity.</p>
